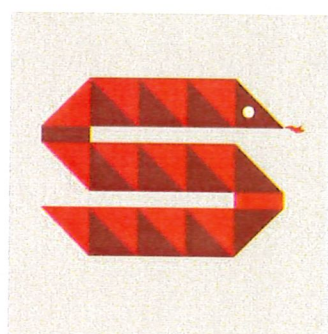

NASCE

The Network of Accredited Skills Centres in Europe, known as NASCE, was established in September 2014 as a Multidisciplinary Joint Committee (MJC) of the Union Européenne des Médecins Spécialistes (UEMS) and supported by 21 sections and boards of the UEMS. NASCE follows UEMS statutes, rules and directives.

The intent of NASCE is to enhance the standards for the operation of Clinical Skills Centres, within the European Union (EU) and EU affiliated countries in the UEMS area, through assessment and accreditation. NASCE promotes individual, inter-professional and multidisciplinary clinical skills education and aims to advance the science of clinical education, training, and assessment.

NASCE provides a comprehensive accreditation programme for centres delivering clinical skills training. This includes assessment of individual, group and team training, as well as research and development of clinical educational institutes.

NASCE annual scientific meeting

NASCE organizes an annual scientific meeting. The first took place in Istanbul in 2015, followed by Dublin in 2016, Lund in 2017 and Copenhagen 2018.

The 5th meeting will take place in Stockholm 26-27 September 2019. Local organiser is CAMST, Center for Advanced Medical Simulation and Training.

The purpose of this 1½ day scientific meeting is to discuss high stakes skills training and simulation among the directors of the 11 accredited centres and affiliated staff, preceded by a two-day train-the-trainers (TtT) course.
